

1. Registration Guidelines

- 1.1 The deadline of the registration for the 1st NUSRL legal Aid Fest, 2015 21st April.
- 1.2 The deadline for depositing registration amount is 25th of April.
- 1.3 Once the participants have deposited the registration amount, they shall not be allowed to withdraw from the respected events or back out from the competition.

2. Payment Details:

2.1 For the event, we are accepting payment only via Demand Draft. Please note that no part payment will be accepted.

- 2.2 Registration Fees for Teams (Including Accommodation & fooding): INR 700 per participant.
- 2.3 For teams who do not require accommodation, team registration fee for the "street play competition" will be INR 1,500 per team
- 2.4 Follow the steps mentioned herein to complete your payment process:
- **Step 01**: Upon completion of filling up of the Registration form, for payment of registration fees a Demand Draft (D.D.) in favour of REGISTRAR NUSRL, RANCHI payable at Ranchi as per the details mentioned hereunder is to be prepared.

Street Play Competition

Through the medium of Street Play popularly known as *Nukkad Naatak*, the youth influence the views of the society by spreading awareness and urging them to take stand against social evils. Being part of such culture of *Nukkad Naatak*, the members of **CLAP** invite you to be a part of this energizing event and leaving an significant mark behind.

RULES:

National University of Study and Research in Law Ranchi

- 1. **Number of Participants:** 7-12 members including instrumentalists (optional)
- 2. Theme: Any social issue
- 3. The event includes **two rounds**: Prelims and Finals.
- 4. **Time limit**: For Prelims : 8- 10 mins

For Finals: 10- 15 mins

- 5. **Medium of Communication**: English / Hindi/ any dialect of Hindi
- 6. **Props**: Only sticks, banners, dupatta and posters are allowed, any use of props other than the mentioned would lead to disqualification.
- 7. The use of similar costume is appreciated although not necessary.
- 8. **Judging Criteria** will be on effective portrayal of theme, expressions, audience's response, 360 degree usage of arena, props and other miscellaneous effects.
- 9. The last date for registration is 25th April 2015. Any application after the mentioned date will not be considered.
- 10. The teams must mention their themes along with their script during the registration.
- 11. The date of conduction of *Street Play Competiton* Prelims in on 2nd May, 2015. All the participants must reach the venue by 3:00p.m.

GENERAL RULES

- 1. Damages to the property of site of accommodation or any damage to the NUSRL campus will not be condemned.
- 2. Participants are solely responsible for their belongings. Organising team does not bear any responsibility for the same
- 3. Any person found in possession of, or under the influence of alcohol or narcotic substances will be expelled from the premises. They will further be reported to their concerned college authorities.
- 4. Any person in indecent clothing or involved in obscene behaviour will result in cancellation of his/her registration and disqualification from the fest. The decision of the authorities will be final in this regard.
- 5. The participants are supposed to conduct themselves with dignity, modesty and simplicity.
- 6. The Rules governing the conduct of the Competition should be strictly adhered to.

 Any deviation thereof can attract penalties or disqualification at the sole discretion of the Competition Administrator.
- 7. All the participants should carry their college / University I-cards and a team bonafide certificate/Registration form attested by the head of the institution.
- 8. The decision taken by the judges in all the events will be final.
- 9. In case of any issue, the decision taken by the Organisers will stand final.
- 10. These rules stated above are subject to change on the discretion of the organisers.
